ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION /

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Threshold Development Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on September 2, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Conoco A State Well No. 1Y located in Unit F of Section 10. Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Atoka formation adjacent to the Turkey Track-Atoka Gas Pool and from the Morrow formation adjacent to the Turkey Track-Morrow Gas Pool

Now, on this 22nd day of September, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no ojections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFOR ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Threshold Development Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Conoco A State Well No. 1Y located in Unit F of Section 10, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Atoka formation adjacent to the Turkey Track-Atoka Gas Pool and from the Morrow formation adjacent to the Turkey Track-Morrow Gas Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the the Division may deem necessary.
