The surface use and operations plan for the proposed Lake McMillan Federal Unit Well #1 is as follows:

1. Existing Roads:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a general highway map, showing location of proposed well as staked. Go north on Canal Street out of Carlsbad, New Mexico, on State Highway 239 approximately 5 miles north of the Pecos River. Turn left and travel 8 miles northwest, turn right and travel 3.8 miles north. Turn left on road to be improved 1.2 mile to proposed new road which turns north 300' to proposed location. The proposed new roadway is flagged to proposed location. Legal location of the proposed well is 1450' FSL & 150' FEL, Section 30, T19S, R27E, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- B. Exhibit A and C are plats showing all existing roads within a one-mile radius of the wellsite, and the planned access road.

2. Planned Access Roads:

- A. Length and Width: Required new road will be 300' long and 12' wide, constructed of caliche compacted and watered to a depth of six inches. The new road is labeled and color-coded red on Exhibits "A" and "C". Road to be improved is 1.2 miles long and color-coded blue on Exhibits "A" and "C".
- B. Turnouts: None required
- C. Culverts: None required
- D. Cuts and Fills: None required
- E. Gates and Cattleguards: None required
