In order to maintain your leasehold production status, this is to advise that Phillips will take a maximum of 50 Mcf/Day of produced gas from the Pecos River 21 Fed COM No. 1 on or before November 16, 1984. It is understood that the production in November, 1984 will be sufficient to hold your lease for the 60-day production period ending on November 16, 1984. In addition, a like amount of production will be accepted in January, 1985 to cover the respective 60-day production period ending January 16, 1985.
