- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS: Existing wells in the vacinity of the proposed drillsite are shown on Exhibit "C".
- 4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:
 - A. L.C. 029353(a) is a producing lease with the central tank battery located about 100' south-southwest of Well #1 McFadden.
 - B. If the well is productive, the flowline from the well will be laid on top of the ground and tied into the gathering system in C-NE-NE of Section.
 - C. Proposed electric line will be run from the well to an existing powerline located on the well pad of Well #4 McFadden.
- 5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY: It is not planned to drill a water supply well. Water for leasehold operations will be purchased from a commercial water hauler.
- 6. <u>SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS</u>: Caliche will be obtained from a State pit located in the NE-NW 2-19S-31E.
- 7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL:
 - A. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the drilling pits.
 - B. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the drilling pits until the pits are dry.
 - C. Water produced during tests will be disposed of in the drilling pits.
 - D. Oil produced during tests will be produced into temporary test tanks.
 - E. Trash, waste paper, garbage, and junk will be buried in a trash pit and covered with a minimum of 24 inches of dirt. All waste material will be contained to prevent scattering by the wind. Location of the trash pit is shown on Exhibit "D".
 - F. All trash and debris will be buried or removed from the wellsite within 30 days after finishing each drilling and/or completion operation.
- 8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES: None anticipated.
