Circulated and conditioned hole. Ran 289 Jts. 5 1/2" OD, N-80, 17 & 20#, LT & C Casing (12,097.15'). Set casing @ 12,115.15' KBM. Cemented w/100 Sxs. Class "H" followed w/285 Sxs. Class "H" foamed w/50,400 SCF of Nitrogen, followed w/825 Sxs. Class "H" + .9% CF-9 + .2 AFS + 2% KCL + .2 PF-4. Plug down @ 12:15 p.m., CST, 1-17-83. Bumped plug w/500 psi over pumping pressure - held. Slacked off from 155,000# to 60,000# and set slips. Nippled down and cut off casing. Packed head and installed tubing head and bonnett. Released rig @ 6:30 p.m., CST, 1-17-83. Ran temperature survey, found T.D. inside the 5 1/2" csg. @ 12,045' and found top of good cement outside the 5 1/2" csg @ 8,420' and top of foam cement @ 5,642'. Now waiting on completion unit.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
