Great Western Drilling Company respectfully requests administrative approval of application to dispose produced water from the Mabel Hale Federal #1 into Amax Chemical Corporation's tailings pond, which is located in parts of Sec. 10 (NM 0560353) Sec. 14 (NM 01085) and Sec. 15 (NM 0243916).
