of gas to be flared is 32 MCF; Value \$80 per day.

C. Name and location of the nearest gas gathering facility:

Phillips Petroleum Lee Gas Gathering Facility

D. Distance 3½ miles Estimated cost of connection \$40M

E. This exception is requested for the following reasons:

The expected purchaser, Phillips Petroleum Co., is currently testing these wells and analyzing the gas. Following these results, Phillips will need an expected four months to receive right-of-way approval from the State of New Mexico to lay a gas pipeline to the tank battery. Once ROW approval has been given and the pipeline laid, gas will no longer be flared.
