## AMENDMENT

Multipoint Surface Use and Operations Plan Hanley Petroleum, Inc. Marathon-Martinez Federal No.1 660' FSL and 1980' FEL Section 31, T-19S, R-29E, Eddy Co., New Mexico Lse. No. NM-13237

This amendment is submitted relative to, and should be made a part of, the original Surface Use Plan filed with Form 3160-3 on June 20,1985. Only the proposed access route is affected by this amendment. No other changes are being made.

## Item 1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. Exhibit A is a copy of the USGS topographic map of the area on a scale of approximately 1" = 8000', showing the location of the proposed wellsite and the planned access route. Exhibit B is a detail map showing all existing roads within a 4-mile radius of the wellsite and the planned access route.
- B. DIRECTIONS: Go 7-3/4 miles east of Carlsbad on US 62-180. Turn north on Eddy County Rd. 243 for 6 miles, then west on Co. Rd. 238 for 2 miles, then north on Co. Rd. 242 (unpaved) for 3 miles, then east approximately 1 mile to the proposed location.
- Item 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD
  - A. The proposed new road will be approximately 1 mile long, beginning at the Winchester Water Station and proceeding east-northeast to the proposed location along the route originally reserved for the temporary water line from the water station to the proposed location. The water line will now run parallel to the proposed road in the same right-of-way.
  - B. The new road will be 12 ft. wide and will be covered with 6 inches of caliche, watered and compacted, with a 6 inch crown and drainage on both sides. No turnouts will be necessary.
  - C. The centerline of the proposed route has been staked and flagged, and an archeological clearance has been obtained for a 50 ft. right-of-way along this route. A copy of the clearance report is attached.
