Dear Mr. Lee,

In reference to the above well, I'm returning your application received on March 21, 2002 as incomplete. In order to process and approve your request, the following information needs to be re-submitted on the correct forms, plus additional information is required:

- Your intention to plug back to a different reservoir needs to be submitted on NMOCD Form 101. Plugging back a well to a different reservoir <u>is not</u> performing remedial work The State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's (NMOCD) Rules and Regulations-Rules 1101.A,B & C explain in detail what is required.
- Form 102 is also needed. Please review Rules 1102.A, B & C for further information on this subject.
- Please note your type of intended use of blow out prevention equipment. NMOCD's Rules 109.A, B, & C and Rule 114.B can provide you with additional information.
- A CIBP with 35' cement set above the CIBP needs to be set 'immediately' above the Delaware perforations. A 100' cement plug or 25 sacks of cement above zone of interest, whichever is greater, and tagged may be used in lieu of a CIBP set 50-100' above the Delaware perforations. Please describe in detail your selected procedure.
