- 1. The estimated tops of important geologic markers are shown on the attached Proposed Well Plan Outline.
- 2. The estimated depths at which anticipated water, oil, gas or other mineral-bearing formations to be encountered are shown on the attached Proposed Well Plan Outline.
- 3. A drawing of an API Series 900 Blowout Preventer Specification is attached. Pipe rams and blinds will be checked to the working pressure of the stack of 70% of the minimum internal yield strength of the casing whichever is less. BOPD will be checked when casing string is set.
- 4. The proposed casing program is as follows:

0'-1200' - 9-5/8", 36#, K-55 0'-8100' - 7", 26#, K-55

5. The proposed mud program is as follows:

0'-1200' - 8.33 Fresh gel & lime 1200'-8100' - 8.33-8.5 Fresh water

- 6. Run open-hole logs from 3000'-8100'. The log suite will include the following: 1) GR-DLL-MSFL-CAL, 2) GR-CNL-LDT-CAL. A temperature survey will be run to determine the top of cement on each casing string where cement is not circulated.
- 7. Possible lost circulation zones 250'-1000'. Deviations from $4^{\circ}-6^{\circ}$ likely from 3000'-6000'. $H_{2}S$ possible from Cisco.
- 8. The anticipated starting date is December 1, 1988 with a duration of approximately 25 days.
