1. EXISTING ROADS:

A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Point "A" on the plat is on Eddy County road 34, approximately 14 road miles south of Artesia and 25 road miles north of Carlsbad, New Mexico, where a paved road (Eddy 37) goes east. There is a Forest Lee Sign here. To go to the proposed well site from this point go east and north 2.1 miles to arrive at the end of Eddy road 37 near ranch house. Also see Exhibits "B" and "D". Turn north at this point across Four Mile Draw and go 0.5 mile to arrive at Enfield's well No.1 North McMillan. Continue northeast through the cattle guard and then east 1.0 mile to a north-south caliche road. Turn north and go 0.5 mile to arrive at Enfield's well No. 1 Walters Fee. The proposed well site is 3960 feet north and 1320 feet west of this well.

B. Exhibit "B" shows existing pertinent roads in the vicinity of the proposed well site. Existing roads are color coded.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

A. Length and Width: The new access road will be 12 feet wide and about 4600 feet long, and is shown labeled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The centerline of the proposed road is staked and flagged.

B. Surfacing Material: Caliche. Watered, compacted, and graded.

C. Maximum Grade: Less than one percent.

D. Turnouts: Possibly two.

E. <u>Drainage design</u>: The new road will be crowned with drainage to the side.

F. <u>Culverts</u>: No culverts are planned. Low-water crossings will be used where necessary to cross drainages.

G. Cuts and Fills: None necessary.

H. Gates and Cattle Guards: None needed. No fences involved.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

A. Existing wells in the immediate area are shown on Exhibirs "B" and "D".
