Dear Mr. Beardemphl:

Reference is made to your application dated June 19, 1990 for an unorthodox location on the subject well. Administrative approval cannot be granted in this matter per General Rule 104 F.I. which states in part:

"The Division Director shall have authority to grant an exception to the well location requirements of Section B and C above without notice and hearing when the necessity for such unorthodox location is based upon topographical conditions, the recompletion of a well previously drilled to a <u>deeper</u> horizon, provided said well was drilled at an orthodox or approved unorthodox location for such original horizon."

Since the subject well was <u>deepened</u> from the North Dagger Draw Upper Pennsylvanian Pool (in which the location is standard) to the Morrow formation, this provision does not apply and therefore requires a hearing before an Examiner for processing.
