

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE PLAN PACHECO FED. #7

1. Existing Road

To reach proposed location start at Hobbs NM travel west to mile marker 44 approximately 60 miles. Turn right on Co. Rd. #243 go 13.2 miles to Illinois Camp Road. Turn right go 2 miles. Turn right on caliche road go 1/2 mile to new location. Exhibit A

2. Planned Access Roads

1,000' of new access road is required.

3. Location of Existing Wells

Exhibit B shows existing wells within a one mile radius of proposed well.

4. Location of Production Facilities

A 2 3/8" steel flowline will be laid to current production facilities in NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 31.

To protect livestock and wildlife, the reserve pit will be fenced.

Upon completion of drilling, the location and surrounding area will be cleared of all debris. All trash will be disposed of in the trash pit.

5. Water Supply

Water for drilling and completion operations will be purchased from a supplier and transported to the well site by truck.

6. Source of Construction Materials

Chevron plans to excavate a 25,00 cubic yard pit in Sec. 31, T-19-S R-28-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

7. Methods of Handling Waste Disposal

A. The drill cuttings, fluids, and completion fluids will be placed in the reserve pit. The reserve pit will be fenced on three sides away from the pad during drilling and the fourth side as soon as the rig moves out. The
