

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

WOODBINE PETROLEUM, INC.
HADSON FEDERAL #2
1,650' FSL AND 2,180' FEL
SECTION 11, T19S, R31E
EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, application for permit to drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of operations so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS

A. Reduced section of a USGS topographic map showing existing lease roads and location. The scale is one inch equals 3,000 feet.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Proceed west from Hobbs on US 62-180 for 36 miles.
2. Turn right on (north) on State Highway 176 and continue for 4.2 miles.
3. Turn right (north) on county road 126A and continue 4.5 miles and turn left (west) go approximately 2 miles then north approximately one mile to the location.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD

A. See Item 1.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS

A. The locations of existing active wells located in and immediately adjacent to Section 11 are highlighted on Exhibit "C".

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND PROPOSED FACILITIES

A. There is one producing well, the Hadson Federal #1, Section 11 T19S R31E, Eddy County, 660' FSL and 2,180' FEL.
