Reference is made to your request dated July 9, 1992, for authorization to downhole commingle Upper Penn and Wolfcamp production within the Conoco "AGK" Fed Com Well No. 6 located in Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. As per the conversation with you on September 3, it is my understanding that the Upper Penn formation has been completed in the subject well at this time. It is further my understanding that the Wolfcamp was not perforated in the well. Please advise the Division as to your plans regarding commingling of the Penn and Wolfcamp zones in this well. If you wish to pursue commingling approval, I will require testing and production data from the Upper Penn zone as well as a bottomhole pressure.

Please advise me at your earliest convenience whether you wish to pursue or withdraw the subject application.
