to the southwest in the vicinity of the access road and southwest in the vicinity of the drill pad. Regional slope is south toward the Stinking Draw which is approximately 2 miles from the location.

- B. Soil: Sandy loam with limestone outcropping.
- C. Flora and Fauna: The flora consists of typical desert vegetation, such as yucca, cactus and various grasses. Fauna consists of desert wildlife such as coyotes, rodents, snakes, deer and antelope.
- D. <u>Ponds or Streams</u>: Stinking Draw is about 2.0 miles south of the proposed location.
- E. Residences and other Structures: Corrals and windmill 1/2 mile east.
- F. Archaeological Historical and Other Cultural Sites: McKay's operation will stay within previously disturbed access road and location site as per instructions of BLM. If any further surveys are requested we will comply accordingly.
- G. Land Use: Grazing
- H. Surface Ownership: Federal
