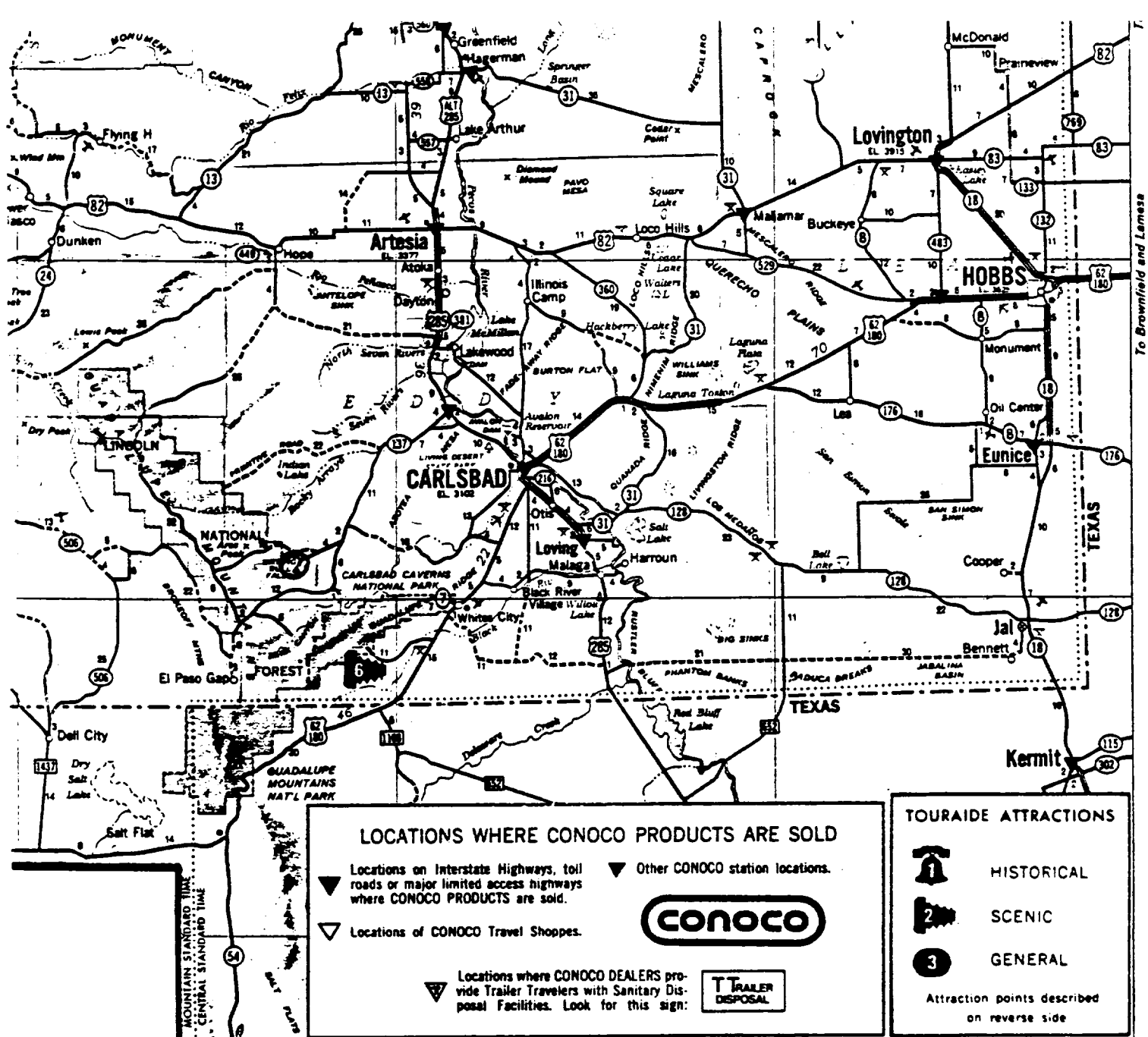




How to read your map of NEW MEXICO
