13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. Propose to squeeze existing perforations 7644-7799' (Canyon) and prep well for drilling department to deepen as follows:

1. TOOH with rods and tubing.
2. Set cement retainer at 7600'. TIH with tubing, stinger with a baffle and plug catcher to sting into retainer. NOTE: Plug container must be loaded before job is started. Squeeze perforations as necessary. Sting out of retainer. Reverse circulate. WOC 24 hours.
3. Drill out retainer and cement. Pressure test casing to 1000 psi. Re-squeeze if necessary until good squeeze is obtained.
4. Release well to drilling department.
