The State of New Mexico is in the process at this time of reviewing leases and determining the number of shut in wells.

Rule 201 A. states "The operator of any well drilled for oil, gas or injection, for seismic, core or other exploration, or for a service well, whether cased or uncas015ed, will be responsible for the plugging thereof."

Rule 2006 B. states "A well will be either properly plugged and abandoned or temporarily abandoned in accordance with these rules within 90 days after: (1) a 60-day period following suspension of drilling. (2) A determination that the well is no longer usable for beneficial purposes. (3) A period of one year in which a well has been continuously inactive."

3.75% tax incentive for wells put back in production. However, if there are no plans to put this well back in service then it needs to either be plugged or properly temporarily abandoned.
