Dear Mr. Berry:

We are starting drilling operation on our Jones-MacArthur State No. 1 well of which you will find a certify location plat enclosed showing exact location. This well is being drilled on lease no. E-952 on the NE SE of section 18, township 19 south, range 28 east, Eddy County, New Mexico. Also you will find enclosed an approved copy of the Notice of Intention to Drill filed with the Oil Conservation Commission. This lease expires August 10, 1956. We are going to carry on a continuous drilling program in a workman like manner until we have reach a depth of approximately 1900 feet or commercial production at a lesser depth. We will write you a letter 20 days from now informing you of our progress and the estimated date of completion of this well either as a dry hole or producer. We request an extention of time on this lease from the State Land Office so that we may be able to complete a producer and validate the lease if possible.

We are also sending in the rentals upon this lease but have not received a rental notice as of yet. Please acknowledge this letter as soon as possible informing us as to your judgment approving our program.

We are starting drilling operation on our Jones-Landman State No. 1 well of which you will find a copy of location of well showing exact location. This well is being drilled on Jones No. 1-992 on the NE 20th section 12, Township 19 North, Range 38 West, 34th County, New Mexico. Also you will find enclosed an approved copy of the Notice of Location to be filed with the Oil Conservation Commission. This lease expires January 1, 1950. We are drilling a continuous drilling program in a 10-acre lease and we have reached a depth of approximately 1800 feet on completion of this well. We will write you a letter 30 days from now informing you of our progress and the estimated date of completion of this well. We request your attention of this well as a lease hole or production. We request your attention of this lease as the State Land Office so that we may be able to lease a pro-ducer and utilize the lease.
