Darrell Atkins, Production Superintendent for Yates Petroleum Corporation, received verbal permission from Jim Amos w/BLM-Carlsbad to use the Polo AOP Federal #2 battery, located in the NWSE (Unit J) of Section 10-T19S-R25E for a temporary storage and sales point for the Ottawa AOW Federal #6. The battery for the Ottawa AOW Federal #6 should be completed by June 13, 1997.

Due to the gas volume, setting a frac tank would pose a safety hazard to the gauger. All production from the Ottawa AOW Federal #6 will be accurately measured by a 48" X 10' 3-phase separator. The production and sales will be allocated back to the well.

Rusty Klein, Operations Technician for Yates Petroleum Corporation, received verbal permission from Ben Stone and David Catanach with OCD-Santa Fe, for temporary storage of production off-lease.
