Penwell Energy, Inc. will lay a 2 7/8", 6.50#, 8rd EUE, J-55 grade steel flowline from the above described well to a temporary gas sales point located at a Santa Fe Energy well in the SW4/SE4 of Sec. 18 -T19S - R31E. This line will follow an existing road way that has been archaeologically cleared. This will be a temporary sales line for a period of three (3) months. Activity is planned to begin in one (1) week. Expected days of construction will be four (4).

This temporary line will be replaced with a new, buried line in approximately three (3) months.

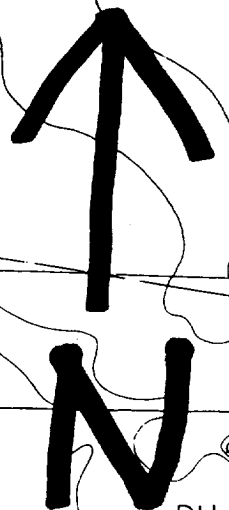
