

SURFACE USE PLAN

RADAR 24 FEDERAL #1

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD :

- A. Length and Width : Access from existing roads will necessitate 300' of new road. The road will be bladed 12' wide with 2' shoulders.
- B. Turnouts : None.
- C. Drainage Design : Road will have a drop of 2" from the center line on each side.
- D. Culverts, Cuts, and Fills : None.
- E. Surfacing Material : Four inches of caliche, bladed, watered, and compacted.
- F. Gates, Cattleguards, and Fences : None.
- G. The proposed road is staked.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS :

- A. Existing wells are shown on the attached Lease Plat

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES :

- A. Existing Facilities : None
- B. New Facilities : On wellsite pad.

5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY :

- A. Water will be purchased from a commercial source and transported over existing roads and the new access road to the wellsite.

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL :

- A. Caliche will be hauled from the nearest approved pit.

7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL :

- A. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the drill pit.
- B. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the drill pits until the pits are dry.
