

Isolate number three consists of 1 fist size piece of burned caliche. Found in the SW1/4SW1/4SE1/4NW1/4NE1/4 of Section 7, T.19S., R.31E.

Isolate number four consists of one deflated hearth with 18 large burned caliche cobbles, measuring 15 cm to 20 cm in size, and 45 smaller fragments broken off from larger pieces. Probes were negative. The isolate was located in a 2 x 2.5 m area on an eroded slope. Found in the NE1/4NE1/4NW1/4SW1/4NE1/4 of Section 7, T.19S., R.31E.

Isolate number five consists of one maroon quartzite distal flake fragment, exhibiting 70% cortex, no use or wear, measuring 3 x 2 x 2 cm. Found in the NW1/4NW1/4NE1/4SW1/4NE1/4 of Section 7, T.19S., R.31E.

Isolate number six consists of 10 pieces of burned caliche, measuring 5 to 10 cm in size. Probes were negative. Located in a 4 x 7 m area in sandy soils with lag gravels. Found in the NE1/4NW1/4NE1/4SW1/4NE1/4 of Section 7, T.19S., R.31E.

#### 16. Management Summary (Recommendations):

During the survey, six isolated occurrences were encountered, recorded and their research potential exhausted in the field. Therefore, **archaeological clearance is recommended** for the Devon SFS Operating, Inc., **proposed Strawberry "7" Federal Number 2 well location and access road**, located in Section 7, T.19S., R.31E, **with no stipulations.**
