Attached are the original and two copies of a Southeast New Mexico Packer Leakage Test report (along with the original charts) showing the results of a packer leaving test made October 13th and 14th on Ralph Lowe's No. 1 Indian Basin dual gas well discovery located in E 23-218-23E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is the operator's intention to file application to dually complete at a later date. Multi-point back pressure tests will also be filed at that time. The purpose of filing the packer leakage test at this time is to comply with the 15-day time limit. Although the well has no outlet at the present time, the packer leakage test was made to establish effective separation of the two gas zones as well as the water zone immediately below the upper Baker Model "D" packer.

It is sincerely hoped that this test will be acceptable.
