DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Landed and cemented 900' of 10-3/4" casing at 905' with 125 sack of cement by use of Halliburton Process. 40' of cement left in the pipe. Cement allowed to set for 85 hours. Hole was bailed dry and after 12 hours no water had entered hole. Plug was drilled and after 12 hours no water entered hole indicating water shut off.
