FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The Ed C. Smith #1 well will not be abandoned as reported on May 17, 1944, but has been turned over to the lessor, Ed C. Smith, who will complete it as a water well.

The well has been plugged back as follows: Hole filled with mud to 2855' by Halliburton. Ten sack cement plug spotted in bottom of 7" casing (2855'-2810'). 7" casing knocked off above cement and pulled. Hole filled with mud to 1700'. Fifty sack cement plug spotted at 1700'. Bailer lost in hole at 1250'. Ten sack cement plug spotted on top of bailer. Top of cement found at 1050'.

The well will produce water from sandy lime at 928' below 10 5/4" casing which will be left in hole.
