Your Notice of Intention to convert and operate as a salt water disposal well under Bureau of Land Management SLUP NM-11382 your No. 1 Springs (SWD), formerly designated as Gulf Oil Corporation's well No. 4 Seven Rivers Hills Unit on oil and gas lease NM-865, located 600/W and 830/E sec. 4, T. 21 S., R. 25 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, by injecting produced waters into the Cisco zone of the Pennsylvanian formation at an interval of 8,300-8,400 feet, is hereby approved subject to the following:

1. The usual Sundry Notice and Reports (form 9-331 in quintuplicate) must be filed with this office prior to commencing any further workover, treatment, suspension of operation, or change of status of this well.
