DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Halliburton pumped 175 sack of mud into hole thru tubing. Bridge hole at 968' and spotted cement plug. Top of plug found at 887', 26' into 10-3/4" casing. Ran collar buster and knocked pipe off. Pulled 764' of 10-3/4" casing leaving 143' in hole. Filled hole to bottom of cellar with mud. Cellar cemented and marker erected.
