We propose to drill this well to an approximate total depth of 2550'. Casing program to be approximately as follows:

13-3/8" - 48# - 250' approx.
10-3/4" - 32# - 700' "
8-5/8" - 24# - 1000' "
7" - 20# - 2450' "

If production in commercial quantities is found, the casing will be cemented as per your instructions. If surface waters are encountered, your office will be contacted and a program worked out to protect surface waters.
