DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well to a total depth of approximately 1250' which should test all shows encountered in the Carper-Sugart #1 well located in the SW 1/4 of Section 22 and the above Township and Range.

We will run approximately 350' of 10 3/4" - 40# casg. and mud, 650' of 8 5/8" - 40# casing and mud, 125' of 7" - 20# mud. casing and cement with 100 sacks of oil is found in commercial quantities to justify producing this well. The outer strings of casing will be pulled if the production string of casing is cemented.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

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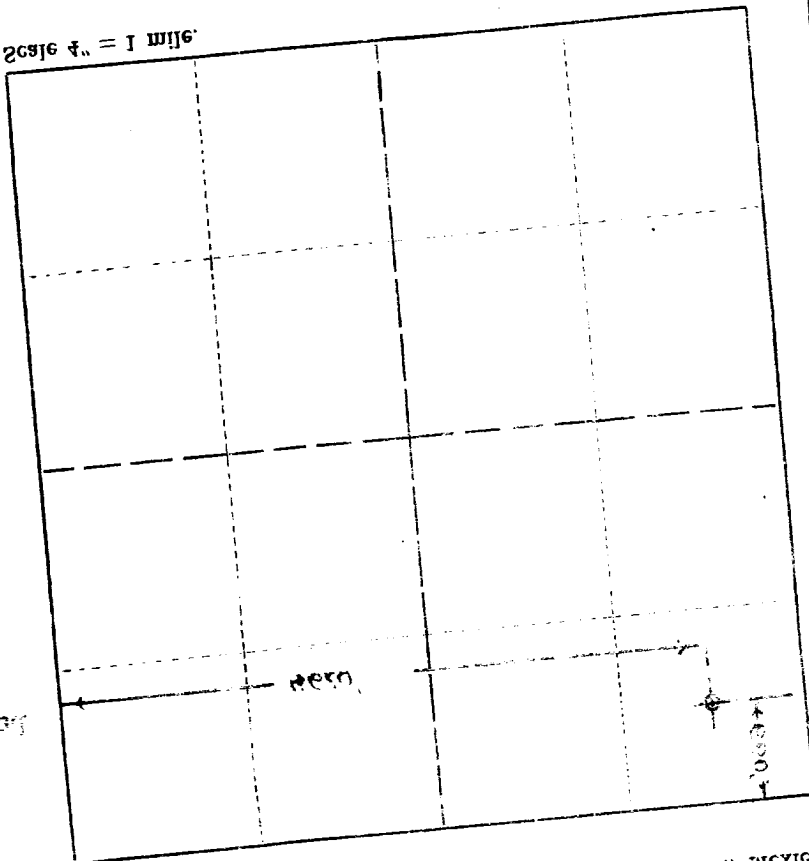

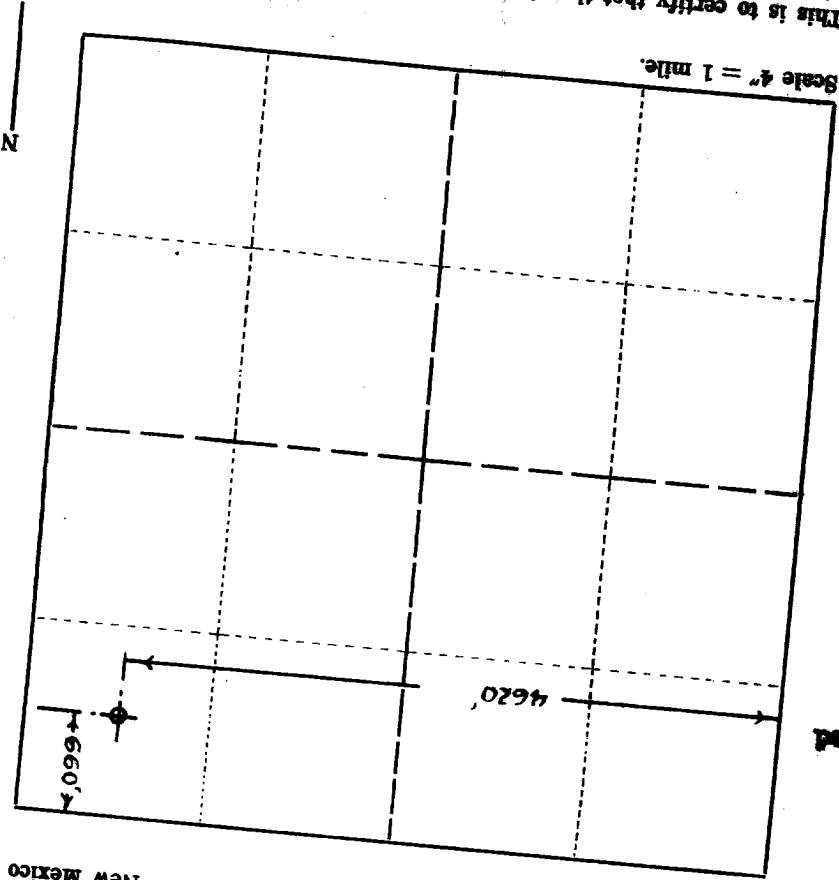
