1. Plug with 40 sacks cement from 2130' to 2014', with 30 sacks from 605' to 550' and from 20' to surface with 12 sacks.
2. All spaces between plugs will be filled with heavy drilling fluid. No casing will be pulled.
3. A 4 1/2" D. P. marker extending 4' above the surface will be set in the top plug and the surface will be cleaned up.
