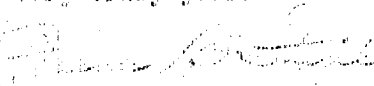

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3354 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

298 ft. 8" casing set on packer at 298 to shut off surface water.
Fishing job at 540 for bit hung in bottom of pipe causing leak.
Ran 6 5/8" casing at 550 with bottom hole Larkin packer and mud
behind same. Absolute shut off of leak.
July 3rd Sunday morning 2 A.M. gas and oil and water unexpectedly blow tools
up hole, well blew until 4 P.M. when control head installed.
July 4, flowed well into tanks till dead. snubbed after running tubing
and flowed well off and on till July 13. Put pumping July 13.
Well is now pumping 120 bbls. water per day and 35 bbls. of oil. Water
mildly sulphur. Pressure on casing 130 lbs. Very little gas being
produced with the oil and water. This appears to be a dirty sand
found 23 ft. above the main body of the "Red Queen" sand found in
#1. Expect to continue to test to see if same holds up.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
