The aforementioned wellbore is located in the stated location according to John W. West, as surveyed from the north and west lines of the section. Kersey and Company Donohue #1, a plugged and abandoned well whose plat shows the same location, is located 40' west of said location or 1980' FNL & 1940' FWL of said section. As per a conversation with John West, the west  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the section is 2602' wide at the latitude of the wellbore instead of the standard 2640'. This would cause an error if any measurements were taken from the east or centerline of the section.

This letter is submitted to attest to the fact that the Potts Federal Com #2 well was not drilled in the plugged and abandoned wellbore.
