
Dear Mr. Yarbrough:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M.,
together with copy of letter, dated October 9, 1941 from the
Oil Conservation Commission, by Carl B. Livingston, Chief Clerk
and Legal Advisor, Santa Fe, New Mexico, which letter is self-
