(near Globe) and enclosed you will please find Notice of Intention to Drill said well on triplicate legal blank forms supplied by your office, which gives more complete details.

By way of information, the Dooley, Dixon, Commerce Well, No. 1, to be drilled on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 18-20-27 is not on the same Commerce Trust Company lease as is the Yates-Dooley, Commerce Well, No. 1 that was recently plugged. (We hold two separate Commerce Trust Company leases in the Globe area.)
