With reference to your letter of April 7, 1954 in regard to a plugging program for the above mentioned well, so as to obtain release of your one well bond -

In view of the fact that you stated in your letter that a local operator was going to take over the well upon expiration of your lease and drill to some greater depth, I see no need for you to plug the well.

The new operator will have to submit a bond in his name to cover his operations if he goes back in the same well, and at the same time your plugging bond could be cancelled.

I plan to be in Carlsbad one day next week and I will discuss this matter with you.
