Dear Sir:

Your Notice of Intention to convert and operate as a water disposal well your No. 5 Welch, on oil and gas lease New Mexico 01149, and located 1050/S and 1050/E sec. 1, T. 21 S., R. 27 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, by injecting the produced waters from wells on the above lease in the Cedar Hills pool, into the next porous zone below the producing zone, is hereby approved, subject to approval of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and subject to the following:

1. If off-lease waters are to be included in this disposal system, a special land-use permit to operate this well as such must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management prior to disposing of any such waters. Inasmuch as the produced waters from the Cedar Hills pool are of low chloride content, disposal of waters into this well is restricted to waters that have no higher chloride content than the produced waters of the Cedar Hills pool.
2. Where applicable and required, right-of-way permits for pipe lines from other leases must be secured from the Bureau of Land Management prior to laying of any such gathering lines.
3. The usual Sundry Notice (form 9-331 in quintuplicate) must be filed with this office prior to commencing any further workover, treatment, suspension of operation, or change of status of this well.
4. A monthly injection report (N.M.O.C.C. form C-120-A acceptable) must be submitted to this office in duplicate.
