Produced waste water has been disposed of into the Riggs 7 Well, part of the same lease and field; occasionally some produced water has been hauled off lease to be disposed of elsewhere, all as has been properly reported on MMS-3160 forms.

Approval has been granted by the NMOCD, for an alternate water disposal via Exxon injection of the produced water in their Avalon Delaware wells in the area of the Cedar Hills Yates Field, a plan supported by BLM personal.

The Riggs 7 Well will remain a part of the disposal system, with varying amounts of injection.
