Dear Mr. Shaw:

I am in the process of obtaining a buyer for the above wells along with the Welch #6. Since there is possibility and opportunity for producing all the wells of the lease, including these in Temporary Abandonment (TA), I respectfully request a waiverance and extension of your letter's thirty days for filing a program of testing the downhole equipment. This will allow potential buyers the opportunity to adequately assess and provide you with their own program of testing/plugging.

Presently potential purchasers are looking at the possibility of drilling another well location, either for production or water disposal. The location and operation of a water disposal well would effect the economics of either producing the #1 and #3 Welch Wells or plugging same. The casing testing, accompanying production and/or plugging can best be undertaken simultaneously. If a lease purchaser cannot be found in a reasonable time, I will undertake to comply with the BLM July 26, 1990 letter requests without potential purchaser consideration.
