Dear Sir:

Please note that on the March proration schedule no allowables were assigned your Magnolia State #1 and your Pure State #2 and #3 in the Magruder-Yates pool. We regret that this action was necessary, but we will not be able to reinstate the allowables until you have brought your Operator's Monthly Report, Form C-115, up to date. For your Pure State lease, we need a corrected report for August, 1955 and also reports for the months of November, December, and January. For your Magnolia State lease, we need a report for each of the months of November, December, and January. For your information, the C-115 original copy should be mailed to the Oil Conservation Commission, P. O. Box 871, Santa Fe, one copy to Oil Conservation Commission, P. O. Box 2045, Hobbs, one copy to the Oil Conservation Commission, Artesia, and one copy to the transporter connected to the lease.

By copy of this letter, the Artesia Pipe Line Company is officially placed on notice that no further oil should be run from either of these leases until further notice from the Commission. Under separate cover we are mailing you a supply of Form C-115.
