We received the blanks you sent us and as we were to be in "arlsbad Monday the 16th, took them there with us. However, we were unable to get in touch with you Honday, so brogght them to El aso and are attaching them herewith, but we do not know if they are filled out correctly.

We wanted the papers made effective June 30th as we were supposed to start before July 1st, which we did upon your authority.

We are drilling in red beds at approx 100' and if we find water in appreciable quantities before topping the salt, will of course have to set 12" casing, in which case I believe you advised us we would have to use about 10 sacks. In this case, we will have to set 10" at top of salt.

If the papers are not satisfactory, please make us up a set and send them to us for signature.

We are indeed sorry we missed you as we feel that the papers could be best made there on the ground, but am sure we can get them fixed up properly by mail. We have already received from Mr Wells approval of the bond we sent him covering this project.
