On July 1st, 1934, a well was spudded in for the drilling of oil and/or gas 1980' from north and east lines of Sec. 15, Twp. 21S, R.27 E, in Eddy County, State of New Mexico, by the A & M Petroleum Company under direction of A Wm. Rutter and R S Magruder of El Paso.

I understand this well was abandoned after reaching a depth of several hundred feet and a new well started closely adjacent thereto, same Section, Township and Range.

I am writing for the purpose of asking if you will be good enough to advise me what your State Official records show respecting varying depths attained and dates, including your last record of depth and date this record was taken.

El Paso.

I understand this well was suspended
after reaching a depth of several hundred feet
and a new well started about 1/2 mile
same Section, Township and Range.
