Gentlemen:

In reply to your letter of February 2, 1960, we are furnishing the following information on the above-captioned well:

1. Persons drilling this well were R. S. Magruder & A. W. Rutter.
2. The original Lessee was Pacific Coast Land.
3. The date of completion was May 7, 1945.
4. Total depth was 2350 feet.
5. The number and complete description of the lease are not available in this office.

This well was spudded on or about July 1, 1934 and was drilled to a total depth of 1553 feet. We have no record of any more operations until February 7 to 14, 1944. R. S. Magruder submitted a \$5000 one-well plugging bond by Maryland Casualty Co. On February 19, 1945, he reentered this hole and drilled to a total depth of 2350 feet and abandoned the well.
