Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains. The *Agrobacterium* strains were incubated with the plant explants for 2 weeks. The explants were then cultured on the selective medium. The number of explants transformed was counted. The results are the mean \pm SD of three independent experiments. * indicates a significant difference ($p < 0.05$) between the control and the *Agrobacterium* strains.
