Gentlemen:

On August 9, 1973, hearing was held before the Oil Conservation Commission in which you were provided an opportunity to appear and show cause why the above captioned wells should not be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Commission-approved plugging program. Fireman's Fund American Insurance Companies had no representative at this hearing nor were any other appearance made. The wells were ordered plugged and abandoned in Commission Order No. R-4616 a copy of which is attached.

Mr. W. A. Gressett, Supervisor of Oil Conservation Commission District II, in Artesia, has advised this office that as of this date, the subject well has not been plugged nor has he been contacted by either Mr. Burgett or a representative of Fireman's Fund.

We hereby make demand upon your company to plug the abovedescribed wells in accordance with a Commission-approved plugging program. Mr. Gressett must be contacted for an appropriate plugging program and given an opportunity to witness the plugging of the well as it is being accomplished.
