Dear Mr. Rains:

I am writing in regard to your application for conversion of one of the Pure State Wells to salt water disposal. Your application also asks the Commission to rescind its previous plugging orders on these wells.

The case will be advertised for hearing, based on the information you gave Mr. Derryberry this morning. The hearing is scheduled for 9:00 o'clock a.m. on October 22, 1975, in the Oil Conservation Commission Conference Room, State Land Office Building, Santa Fe.

You must also file a formal application in writing with the Commission. This may be done in the form of a letter which requests authorization for salt water disposal. The letter must contain the name of the well, its description, the formation into which you propose to dispose of produced water, and the depth of the perforated interval or open-hole. This letter must be received not later than October 12, 1975.

Enclosed is a copy of Oil Conservation Commission Form C-100 and two pages from the Commission Rules and Regulations. You will need to have all information indicated on this form and by Rule 701 A & B at the time of the hearing.
