


This letter is to confirm that discussions have recently been held with Barber Oil, Inc., concerning the continued use of Wills well No. 5 in the Russell Pool Waterflood program, Eddy County, New Mexico.

At the present time, consideration is being given towards cementing the old casing above and below the salt section and running new casing inside in an effort to replace this well back on injection status. In the past this well has been an excellent injection point and has improved the oil production in the project area. For this reason, the plan presently is to place the well in an acceptable position and to utilize the well for injection purposes in a manner satisfactory to the Oil Conservation Commission in the immediate future.
