DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Following telephone permission to plug and abandon the well the bottom hole water was shut off by dumping five sacks of calcealand ten sacks of cement with the bailer. The rig was shut down for three days and the hole bailed dry. Tools stopped 60' off bottom. The water was proven to be shut off.

Following the plan stated in "Notice of Intention to Drill" 206' of 8 7/8" casing and 607' of 7" casing was pulled and the hole filled with mud. Dry hole marker is in place. The pit is filled.
