9-10-57 Prepared to abandon well. Circulated Aqua-gel to surface through 900 feet of 2 inch tubing. Pulled tubing to 500', set 10 sack plugs 500' to 400'. Pulled tubing to 150', set 10 sack plug 150' to 120'

11-18-57 Set 4" x 8' steel marker - cemented with 2 sacks cement and filled pipe with cement. Used bulldozer; cleared and leveled drilling site.

7" casing cemented at 582' - was shot at 489' - left 93' of 7" in hole.

254' of 8 5/8 casing pulled completely.
